Top British Air Victories of the RAF and Fleet Air Arm in WWII
E.g. Ranked first, this RAF Supermarine fighter with 5,950 victories – Spitfire
Ranked second, this Hawker fighter with 4,540 victories - Hurricane

1a	Ranked 3rd this Bristol aircraft was a development of one of their earlier bombers and was known by the Japanese as the “whispering death” for when it made low level ground attacks, they did not hear it coming until too late. It claimed 965 victories.	Bristol Beaufighter
1b	Ranked 4th. This De Havilland aircraft was originally an unarmed bomber. But when given machine guns and cannons it became a deadly day and night fighter with 835 victories.	De Havilland Mosquito
2a	Ranked 5th. One of the first American aircraft brought into service by the RAF, this Curtiss aircraft gave sterling service in many theatres of the war claiming 680 victories	Curtiss Tomahawk or Kittyhawk
2b	Ranked 6th. This Gloucester aircraft, a biplane, was obsolete even when it first came into service but gained fame in the early days of the siege of Malta with 304 victories during the war.	Gloucester Gladiator
3a	The top scoring naval fighter was a two seat aircraft built by Fairey which scored 112 victories.	Fairey Fulmar
3b	Ranked 8th. Better known for it’s ground attack role, this Hawker aircraft scored 246 victories.	Hawker Typhoon
4a	Ranked 9th. Another Hawker aircraft was a follow-on to the previous aircraft. It excelled in low to mid-air combat and claimed 239 victories.	Hawker Tempest
4b	Ranked 10th. This North American Aviation aircraft destroyed 185 aircraft in RAF service	North American Mustang

Sp	Ranked 7th. This Avro bomber destroyed 320 aircraft just defending itself.	Avro Lancaster
